Ultra-orthodox	10%	On-line (Zoom) + In School (Physical)

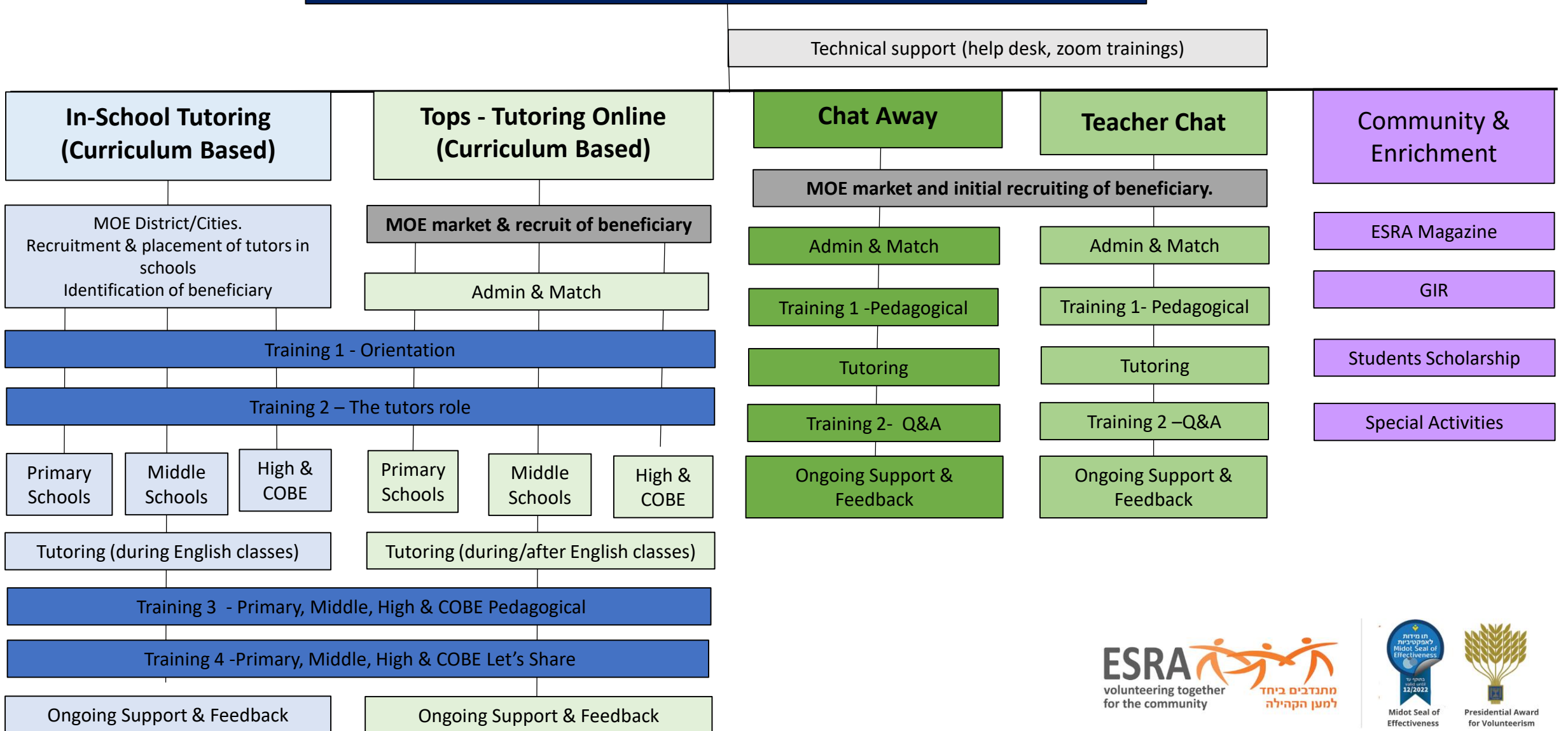
