ESRA TOPS Program (Tutoring Online Program)

ESRA Tops - Tutoring Online Program for Students is one of ESRA's English Tutoring Programs (ETP). It offers students from 5th - 9th grade the opportunity to benefit from tutors to improve their English. Because all the tutoring takes place online, the tutors can live anywhere in the world, not just in Israel. Students are matched with tutors and enjoy zoom sessions at their convenience.

Tutors and students meet weekly, after school, for 40 minutes on Zoom, with cameras, either one-on-one or in small groups. Tutors support students in improving their English vocabulary, reading, writing, and conversation skills.

ESRA Tops tutors are native speakers. They are not teachers but receive ongoing training and support. The program is available for all sectors and requires parents' consent and students' commitment.

English school coordinators choose a maximum of 5 students from each school for a series of 15 sessions. After 15 sessions, the school coordinators choose up to 8 additional students and repeat the procedure.

ESRA Tops Advantages:

- The English teachers have minimal involvement (initial presentation, student selection, completion of short online feedback).
- Tutors receive pedagogical guidance, and resource materials (approved by the MOE English Inspector) from ESRA.
- Volunteers can operate from abroad, as well as from all over Israel.
- Students hear and speak English in a natural setting.

The Procedure:

- The teacher introduces the program to their students and selects up to 5 students who are eager to receive help with their English skills.
- **Register** your students on an online form.
- After the registration, an **ESRA Tops** volunteer will contact the student via WhatsApp to schedule a meeting (please ensure that the students know to expect a message and are willing to make a commitment).
